According to The Indianapolis Star, she has earned more than 40 journalism awards, including Indiana Journalist of the Year and the Will Rogers Humanitarian Award.

She is president of the Indiana Professional Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists and vice president of Girls on the Run of Central Indiana.

AMENDMENT ONE

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances.
